ENTRY FEES

Fee of \$23.00 first entry / Fee of \$16.00 2nd or 3rd entry of same dog (per day)

TRIAL HOURS

Friday, Saturday & Sunday: The trial hours are 6:30 a.m. to 30 minutes after completion of judging.

WAIT LIST

PPAC will offer a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 50 runs per day will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 8:00 p.m. January 7, 2026. Any entries withdrawn prior to that time will be replaced by a wait list entry when available. A full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 5:00 p.m. January 10, 2026, will receive a full refund.

COURSE SIZE AND SURFACE

The ring is indoors on dirt. The course size is approximately 110' x 110' feet.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the Judge's Briefing.

A warm-up area consisting of a single regulation agility jump will be provided.

MOVE-UPS

Dogs may be moved to a higher class only at the <u>request of the owner</u> as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, no later than 5:00 p.m. Monday January 19, 2026, to be effective for the first day of the Trial. For Titles earned during this trial, a move up form must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from for the subsequent days. Dogs so moved will be entered at the end of the running order. Move-ups may be sent in writing or emailed to the Trial Secretary. A move-up email will not be official unless acknowledged by the secretary.

Class Changes effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day:

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights on the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day. A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights on the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL

From the North:

Take I-25 south to Monument (Exit 161). Take Hwy 105 east (away from the mountains) 4.9 miles to Hwy 83. Turn right and go 2.2 miles to Hodgen Road. Turn left and go about 8.6 miles to Meridian Rd. Turn right and go 4 miles to Latigo Blvd. Turn left and go 1.1 miles to the second Halleluiah Trail. Turn left and go to the Latigo Trails Equestrian Center on your right (less than 0.1 miles).

From the South:

Take I-25 to Woodmen (Exit 149) in Colorado Springs. Go east (away from the mountains) on Woodmen 11.2 miles to Meridian Rd. Turn left and go 5 miles to Latigo Blvd. Turn right and go 1.1 miles to the second Halleluiah Trail. Turn left and go to the Latigo Trails Equestrian Center on your right (less than 0.1 miles).

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

Starting Jan.1, 2001, all dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary Jump Height Card issued by the AKC shall be measured by a judge of record prior to competing. Please have your Jump Height card with you at the trial. Measuring of dogs without cards must take place prior to their first class.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any Trial. In traditional agility, dogs may, at the handler's option, be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in Preferred must run in the division appropriate to their height. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Members of PPAC, Latigo Trails Equestrian Center, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

PPAC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against PPAC or any official thereof.

The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the Rules & Regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entries must reach the Trial Secretary by 8:00 p.m. January 7, 2025, or when 330 runs per day have been reached. Fees must accompany all entries. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms. Postdated checks and returned checks will invalidate an entry.

There will be a \$30.00 Service Fee charged for returned checks. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season are not allowed at the Trial. Entry fees for bitches that come into season before the Trial will be refunded, less fees per day for the Judge and Secretary, provided the Trial Secretary is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. Unsigned entries cannot be accepted nor will telephoned entries be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules are not acceptable. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions for its acceptance. Neither the Club nor the Trial Secretary are responsible for legibility or accuracy of contact information provided on completed forms, technical difficulties in electronic communications, or postal delays. It is therefore recommended that handlers email the Trial Secretary 7 to 10 days from mailing their entry to confirm receipt.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 70 online entries and 260 paper entries each day. If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly. Entries using coupons and/or vouchers will be accepted by paper mail in only.

Hand deliveries at the November PPAC trial will be accepted, full payment is required at the time of hand delivery. If you would like to use coupons earned at the November trial, you will have to send a new check and coupons after the trial is over, your original check will be shredded when the new one is received.

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by phone are not acceptable.

For single copies of the Regulations for Agility Trials, write to the AKC, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390 or e-mail info@akc.org. This trial will be conducted in accordance with the Regulations for Agility Trials, effective Jan. 1, 2026.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the AKC or are registerable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration & Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for being ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. PPAC and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for locating dogs that are not at ringside when required.

At the handler's option, dogs may wear flat buckle or quick snap collars, but there shall be no hanging tags or attachments. Choke, pinch, electric, or dummy collars are prohibited.

All dogs must be always on leash and in control at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the

behavior of their dog(s), children, and guest(s). Any exhibitor whose dog(s), children, or guest(s) create Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

All regulations governing the use of this facility and all regulations and decisions of the PPAC Trial of the trials. Committee on these days will be strictly enforced.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and parking areas. Dogs may be exercised ONLY in designated areas. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs AT ALL TIMES. No dogs are allowed overnight at the Trial site.

If an entered dog becomes injured or sick after the closing date but not after the trial has begun, a 50% refund of that dog's entry fee is offered. The refund will be in the form of a voucher to be used at a future PPAC trial. The trial secretary must be notified by writing, including email notification, by 5:00pm the day before the 1st day of weekend trials, that is by 5:00 p.m. Thursday for a 3-day trial that is Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. A letter from a Vet must be provided to the trial secretary no later than 3 business days after the last day of the weekend trials.

Entries overpaid by \$10 or less will not be issued a refund.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is nonqualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

FEO will be offered at this trial!

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.
